Platinum Investor Survivor II is a variable universal life insurance policy issued by American General Life Insurance Company. The table below presents average annual returns for each Platinum Investor Survivor II variable universal life insurance investment portfolio. The returns include reinvestment of dividends and distributions and deductions for management fees and other expenses of the portfolios/funds, including 12b-1 distribution fees where applicable. These returns do not include: (i) mortality and expense risk charges; (ii) all other noninsurance charges and contract fees; and (iii) insurance-related charges, including surrender charges, cost of insurance and monthly expense charges. If these expenses were included, the performance presented below would be significantly lower.
